## **Lustre Rose**

The purple table set is relatively rare since listed sales since 2005. Again, value goes with the rarity and beauty of the piece. This set offers high quality and perfect even color and iridescence on all of its pieces. Who can resist such beauty!



## **Scrool Embossed**



Again Imperial made a purple wavy bowl with a rich iridescence. The value doesn't always do justice to the beauty of the piece. All collectors who have the privilege of owning one of these pieces exhibit it at the first box of their collection.

### **Fruits and Flowers Variant**

Similar to the Three Fruits pattern by Northwood, the Fruits and Flowers pattern is distinguished by the presence of small flowers that point towards the center which in turn does not contain any pattern. But in the case of the piece that Leo is showing us, it's a variation that features a floral arrangement in the center and stippled finish. Only green and orange 7 inch wavy bowls can be found with this very rare variation. We hope to be able to admire him at one of our next meetings.





#### **Diamond Lace**

The Imperial Purple Diamond Lace Pitcher is a classic that can be found relatively easily. Here again it presents in a magnificent way and it presents an asset for any collection. Keep an eye out for marigold pitcher, this color has yet been reported. It would certainly be the jackpot!
